

ELOPE, English Language Overseas Perspectives and Enquiries

Guidelines for Contributors

General

ELOPE publishes original research articles, studies and essays that address issues of English language, literature, teaching and translation. The language of contributions is English.

Manuscripts are welcome from all countries and should be sent to Gašper Ilc, Filozofska fakulteta, Oddelek za anglistiko in amerikanistiko, Aškerčeva 2, 1000 Ljubljana, Slovenia, gasper.ilc@ff.uni-lj.si. Articles for special issues should be sent to the address specified in the respective call for papers.

Submission of Manuscripts

Manuscripts should be submitted for blind review in three anonymous printed copies and in electronic form. A separate sheet with the title of the paper, the name of the author, affiliation and address should be attached. Only one contribution by the same author per volume will be considered. Each paper should be accompanied by abstracts in English and Slovene (between 150 and 180 words each) and keywords. Abstracts by non-native speakers of Slovene will be translated into Slovene by ELOPE. Suggested length of manuscripts is between 5,000 and 8,000 words.

Manuscript Style and Format

Page one should include the following information:

- article title in the language of the article
- name(s) of author(s)
- affiliation(s) of author(s)
- correspondence address (full address, phone number, e-mail address)

The manuscript starts on *page two*, in the following format:

- title in English
- abstracts in English and Slovene
- the paper should be divided into introduction; body of the paper (possibly subdivided); and conclusion.

The text should be paginated, written in Word format, 12-point Times New Roman font size, 2.5 cm page margins on all sides, 1.5- point line spacing, left text alignment. Footnotes are brief (up to 300 words per page; 10-point Times New Roman font size). For resolving practical style and formatting queries, a sample paper is available on the ELOPE [website](#).

Before submitting the article, authors are advised to check the ELOPE Manuscript Submission Checklist. Please note that only manuscripts fully adhering to the ELOPE Guidelines for Contributors will be considered for publication.
